Key Facts about starting a business in China

1. Minimum Company Requirements

- Minimum 1 shareholder (individual or corporate entity).
- Every Company must appoint a Legal Representative (must be a person)
- Company must have a business address. Residential address is not allowed.

2. Easy Incorporation from Overseas

- Company can be fully incorporated remotely, even if you are not in China.

3. Corporate Bank Account Requirements

- Banks require the Legal Representative to be present to open the bank account.

4. Business Scope

- A company can only operate within the registered business scope.

5. Registered Capital

- There are no minimum paid up capital requirement. The common registered capital is RMB100,000 - RMB1,000,000 and should match your business activity and scale.

6. Tax Rate

- The general Corporate Tax Rate is 25% in China however different region and zones may qualify for special tax incentives.

Key Facts about starting a business in China

7. Compliance Requirements

After your company is registered, you must also complete these setup within 30 days.

- Tax bureau registration
- Accounting system setup
- Monthly bookkeeping & tax filing
- Annual audit & annual compliance report

8. Business Licensing

- Certain industries require additional business licenses before operating (F&B, import/export, education, hospitality, etc.).

- The company Legal Representative (if foreigner) must have their Passport notarized at the embassy and to obtain a Verification Card from the China embassy.
- Company registration takes an average of 10 days to complete.
- Allow up to 7 days for Bank Account opening process as you are required to be present at the bank for 2 times.
